This addendum revises the following Contract Documents on the above referenced project:

1. Plan Sheet 2-T – SUMMARY OF QUANTITIES

The quantity for 36” CORRUGATED METAL PIPE should be **72,000 Lin. Ft.**, rather than the 70,000 linear feet shown.

2. Plan Sheet 3 – Build Note at Sta. 10+88

The note should read **“BUILD 36” x 72’ CORRUGATED METAL PIPE...”**, rather than **“BUILD 36” x 70’ CORRUGATED METAL PIPE...”** as shown.

3. Plan Sheet 4 – Build Note at Sta. 10+88 (lower half of sheet)

The note should read **“BUILD 36” x 72’ CORRUGATED MEAL PIPE...”**, rather than **“BUILD 36” x 70’ CORRUGATED METAL PIPE...”** as shown; and below should read **“CULVERT PIPES SHALL BE 14 GA., WITH 2 2/3” x 1/2” CORRUGATION.”**, rather than **“CULVERT PIPES SHALL BE 12 GA., WITH 3” x 1” OR 5” x 1” CORRUGATION.”** as shown.

4. Bid Packet Page 3 – NOTICE TO BIDDERS

In paragraph one, the note should read **“construction of single 36” x 72’ corrugated metal pipe...”**, rather than **“construction of a single 36” x 70’ corrugated metal pipe...”** as shown.

5. Bid Packet Page 12 – PROPOSAL FOR OAK CREEK CULVERT REPLACEMENT

The PLAN QUANTITY for Item 1-3 36” Corrugated Metal Pipe should be **72,000 Lin. Ft.**, rather than the 70,000 Lin. Ft. shown.

The above changes are being made to clarify the intended corrugated metal pipe gauge, corrugation, and length and to ensure the build notes are in conformance with drawings.

PLEASE MAKE THE CHANGES TO THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids will be received by the Lower Platte South NRD until September 1, 2017 at 11:00 a.m., for the construction of a single 36" x 70' corrugated metal pipe on a 0 degree skew with two 30 degree elbows. Bids will be publicly opened at that time, or shortly thereafter. The project is located on the Oak Creek Trail, in the NW quarter of Section 13, Township 13-N, Range 4-E, Butler County, Nebraska.

The project is referred to as "Oak Creek Trail Culvert Replacement" and shall include all labor, materials, transportation, and equipment required to fabricate and construct a single 36" x 70' corrugated metal pipe on a 0 degree skew with two 30 degree elbows.

Copies of the Bid Documents and Specifications are open to public inspection at the office of the Lower Platte South NRD, 3125 Portia Street, Lincoln, Nebraska. A set of bid documents may be obtained from Mainelli Wagner Associates Inc. for a non-refundable fee of \$20.00 (6920 Van Dorn, Suite "A", Lincoln, Nebraska 68506 PH: 402 421-1717). All Bid Proposals must be submitted on the forms furnished with the Bid Documents.

The sealed bids may be mailed or delivered to the office of the Lower Platte South NRD, 3125 Portia Street, Lincoln, NE 68521, and should be plainly marked as, "Construction Bid Proposal – Oak Creek Trail Culvert Replacement".

Along with its Bid Proposal, each bidder shall submit an unconditional Bid Bond or Certified Check made payable to the Lower Platte South NRD, in an amount equal to five (5) percent of the Bid Proposal. The desired completion date is November 30, 2017. Each bidder is to include a start date and completion date with its Bid Proposal. The contractor will not be allowed to start the removals at a site unless they have committed a crew to complete the work at the site.

Within ten (10) days following the award of the contract, the successful bidder shall furnish a surety bond or bonds in an amount equal to or greater than the full amount of the contract. The surety and form of the bonds are subject to the acceptance by the Lower Platte South NRD Board of Directors.

The Lower Platte South NRD Board of Directors reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to waive any irregularities in bids received. Award of the contract will at the discretion of the Lower Platte South NRD Board of Directors, award of the contract will be on the basis of the lowest responsible bid received.
