INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids, for the work described herein will be received until 3:00 pm local time at the place of bid opening, June 5, 2018 at the Lower Platte South Natural Resources District office, 3125 Portia St., Lincoln, Nebraska, and at that time publicly opened. The work includes, but is not limited to:

Furnish all labor, materials and equipment for South Salt Creek Capital Improvement Project #3. Work, per the plans and specifications, shall include tree removal, excavation, construction of rock and boulder grade controls, vegetation of grade controls, site restoration, sediment and erosion control management and all other work identified in the project plans and specifications.

Envelopes containing bids shall be sealed and must be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond in an amount equal to not less than five (5) percent of the amount bid. The check or bond shall be payable to the Treasurer, Lower Platte South Natural Resources District as security that the bidder to whom the award is made will enter into contract to complete the work bid upon and furnished the required bonds and insurance.

No bid may be withdrawn within a period of forty-five (45) days after the date fixed for the bid opening. Work shall be commenced and completed within the time(s) designated in the Bid Form.
