NATURAL RESOURCES CONSERVATION SERVICE REPORT TO THE LOWER PLATTE SOUTH NATURAL RESOURCES DISTRICT April 20, 2022

PERSONNEL:

- USDA Service Center Operations The Lancaster and Cass County Service Centers are now open to walk-in customers. *It's business as usual at NRCS!*
- Devin Heusinkvelt has been promoted to Resource Conservationist in the Weeping Water Field Office. Devin has served as the Soil Conservationist in the Weeping Water office since April 2020 and was in the Oshkosh Field Office for the previous 3 years. Congratulations Devin!

NRD LAND TREATMENT:

- The Conservation/Resources Technicians are busy working with landowners to complete conservation practice installation prior to the April 30th construction deadline. They also continue to process payments as documentation from landowners and contractors is submitted.
- Staff is beginning to verify cover crop installation/termination for the LPSNRD Cover Crop Program. There are over 50 site visits that need to be completed in Cass and Lancaster Counties.

USDA PROGRAMS:

- Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP) Staff is currently assessing and ranking CSP applications for FY22. The deadline to have ranking completed is May 6th.
- Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) Staff is busy assessing and ranking EQIP-Conservation Incentive Contracts (CIC). The deadline to complete the ranking is May 6th. They're also in the process of obligating FY22 Classic EQIP contracts which need to be finished by April 27th.
- An NRCS Local Working Group (LWG) meeting was hosted by the LPSNRD on March 30th. The meeting was held in person and attended by staff and Directors Aldridge, Nolte, and Hellerich. The group had good discussion on USDA conservation program priorities, program ranking criteria, and ranking procedures. The LWG provided recommendations that have been sent to the State Technical Committee and State Conservationist for consideration.
