
TWIN LAKES WATERSHED TARGET AREA PROJECT



What are we doing?

The Lower Platte South NRD (LPSNRD) is partnering with USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service and the Nebraska Department of Environment and Energy on a three-year effort to improve water quality in the Twin Lakes Watershed, with funding from the Section 319 Program.



What can you do?

We're offering enhanced cost-share incentives to producers for installing these practices:
